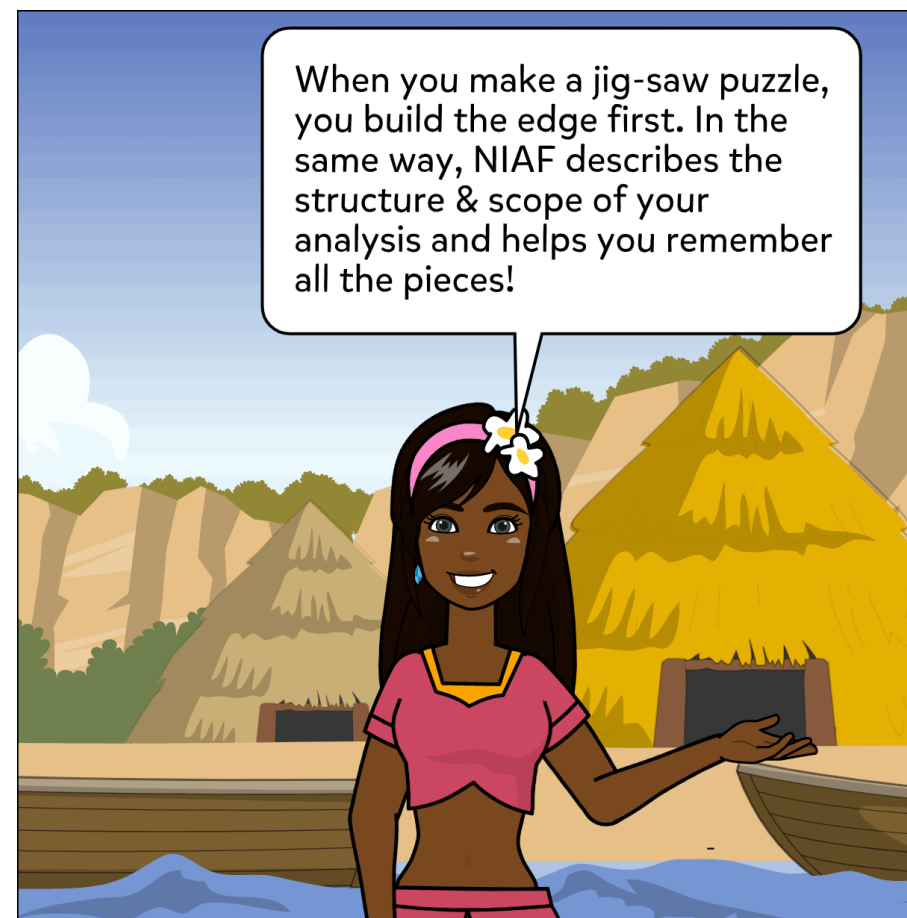
What is the NIAF about?

- Enabling the CP AoR to understand CP needs without having to implement CP Rapid Needs Assessments
- Makes better use of secondary data
- Use quantitative and qualitative information
- Structured process
- Make use on local actors/staff knowledge
- Can be used in any setting



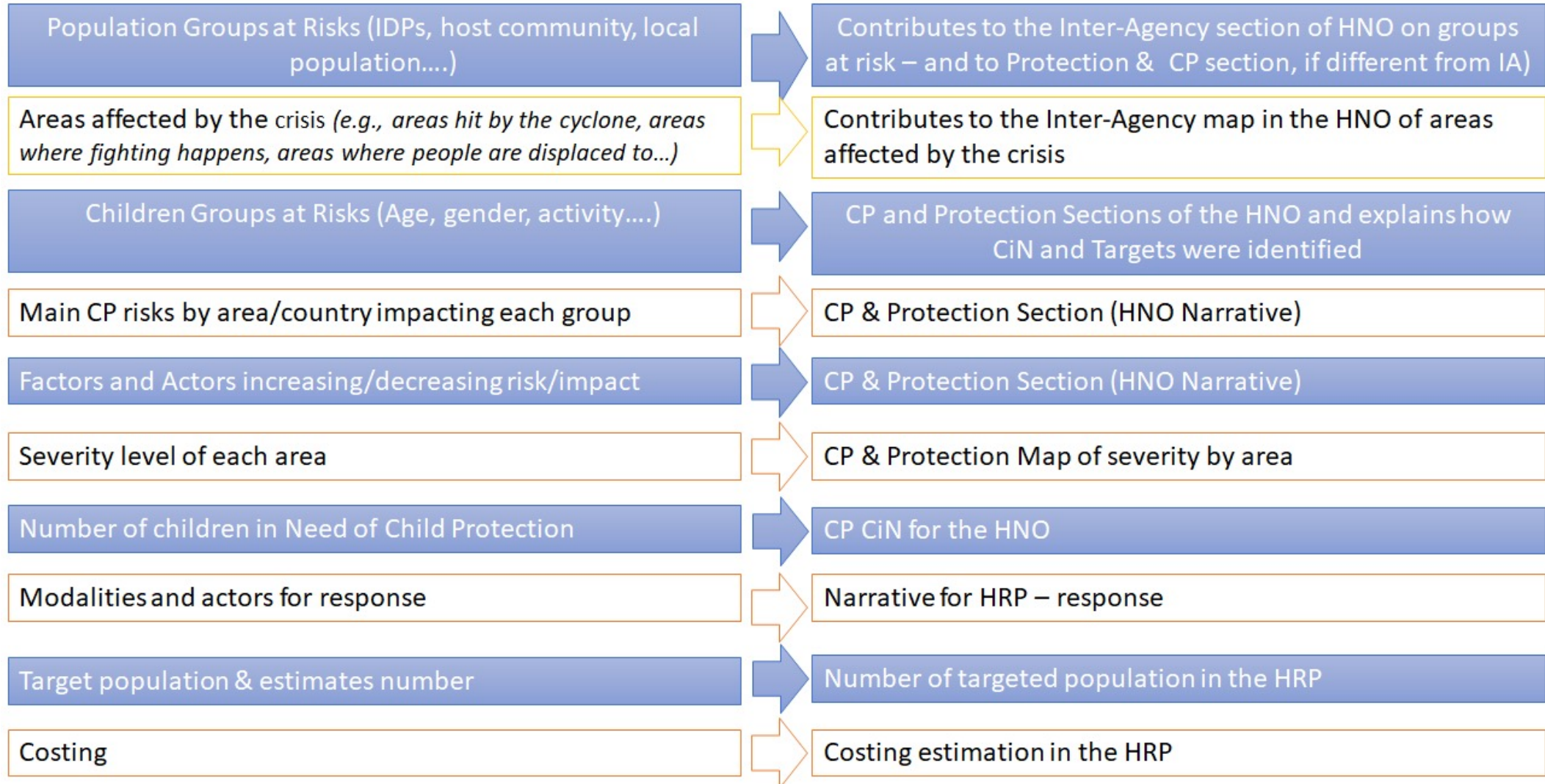

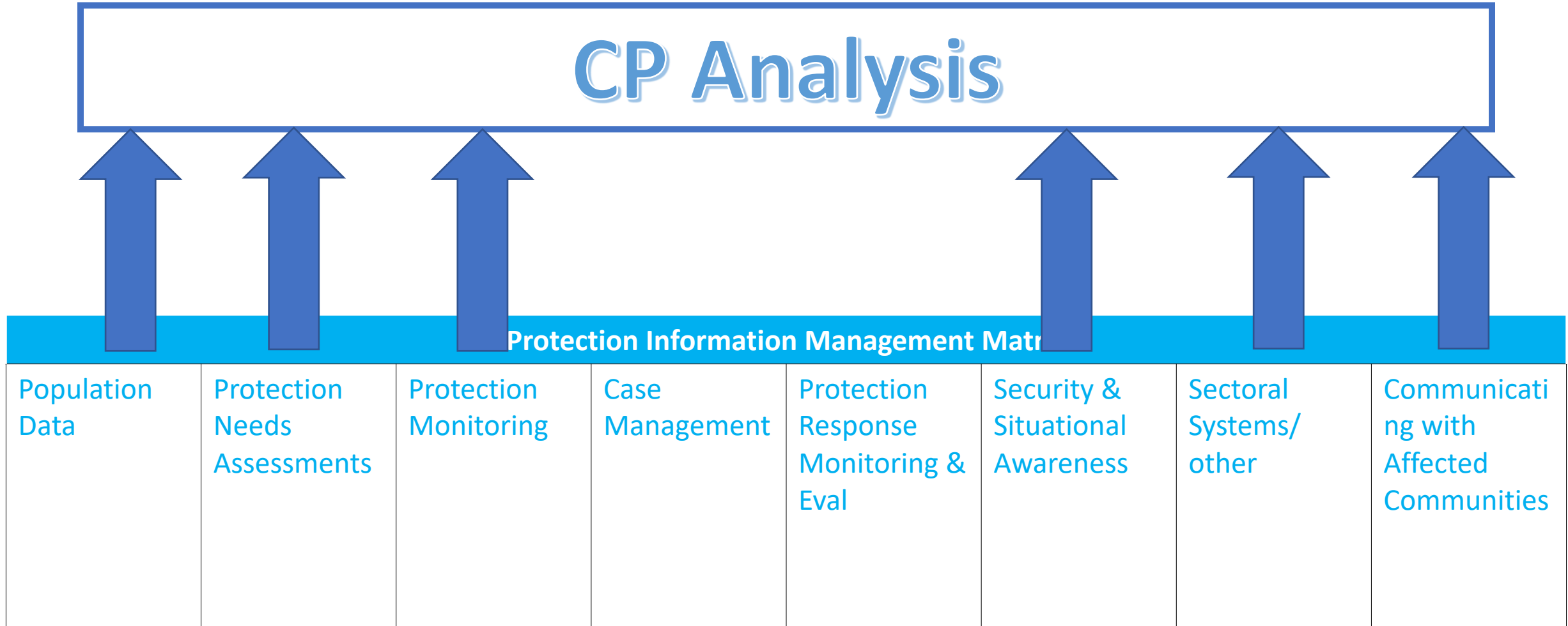


Main outputs of the NIAF

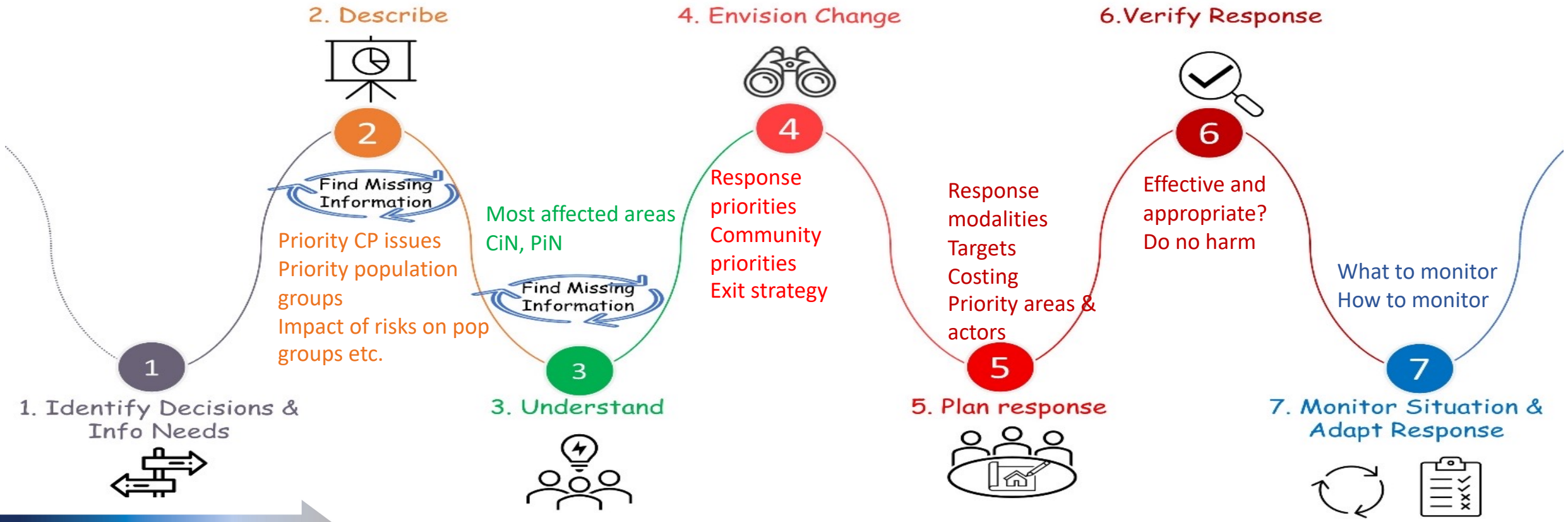


How Does NIAF Relate to the PIM Matrix?



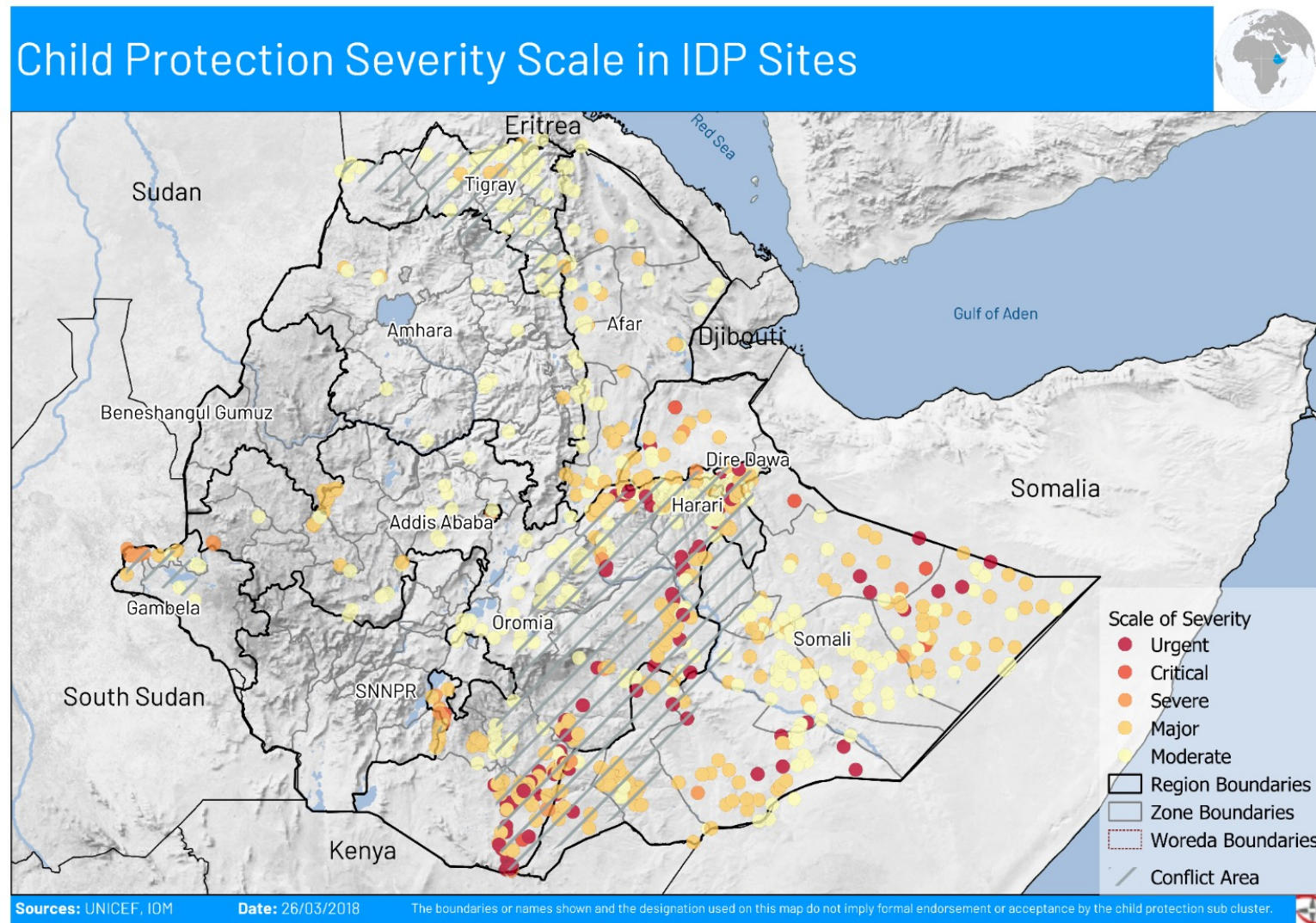


NIAF Steps and PIM Process
