## What's New in PIM?

Shannon Hayes and Daunia Pavone from UNICEF presented at the "What's New in PIM" Webinar on 13 January, 2021. The presentation explained how the PIM Framework is reflected in the development of the NIAF.

## What is NIAF?

The NIAF is an analytical framework for child protection analysis. It:

- Provides the framework to identify needed information and existing sources for child protection analysis
- Guides child protection coordination groups through the process to efficiently gather, analyse and act on information for quality child protection response
- Makes better use of secondary data
- Is a structured process
- Makes use of the knowledge of local actors and staff.
